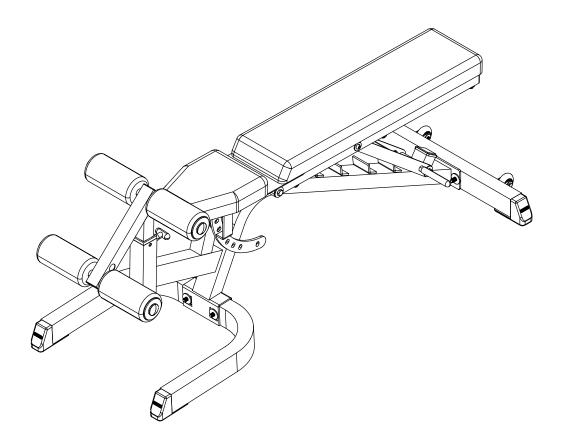

Before You Begin

Thank you for purchasing the GFID-71. This bench is part of the Body-Solid line of quality strength training machines, which lets you target specific muscle groups to achieve better muscle tone and overall body conditioning. To maximize your use of the equipment please study this Owner's Manual thoroughly.

Required Tools

The basic tools that you must obtain before assembling the GFID-71 include but are not limited to:

- Metric Allen Key Set
- O Standard Allen Key Set
- Standard Wrench Set
- Metric Wrench Set
- Adjustable Wrench
- Screwdriver (standard and/or phillips)

Installation Requirements

Follow these installation requirements when assembling the GFID-71:

Set up the GFID-71 on a solid, flat surface. A smooth, flat surface under the machine helps keep it level.

Provide ample space around the machine. Open space around the machine allows for easier access.

Insert all bolts in the same direction. For aesthetic purposes, insert all bolts in the same direction unless specified (in text or illustrations) to do otherwise.

Leave room for adjustments. Tighten fasteners such as bolts, nuts, and screws so the unit is stable, but leave room for adjustments. Do not fully tighten fasteners until instructed in the assembly steps to do so.

Fill out and mail the warranty card.

Assembly Tips

Read all "Notes" on each page before beginning each step.

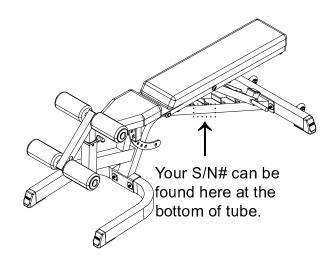
While you may be able to assemble the GFID-71 using the illustrations only, important safety notes and other tips are included in the text.

Some pieces may have extra holes that you will not use. Use only those holes indicated in the instructions and illustrations.

NOTE: With so many assembled parts, proper alignment and adjustment is critical. While tightening the nuts and bolts, be sure to leave room for adjustments.

NOTE: The bottles that are marked "Poison" is your touch up paint. Keep away from children.

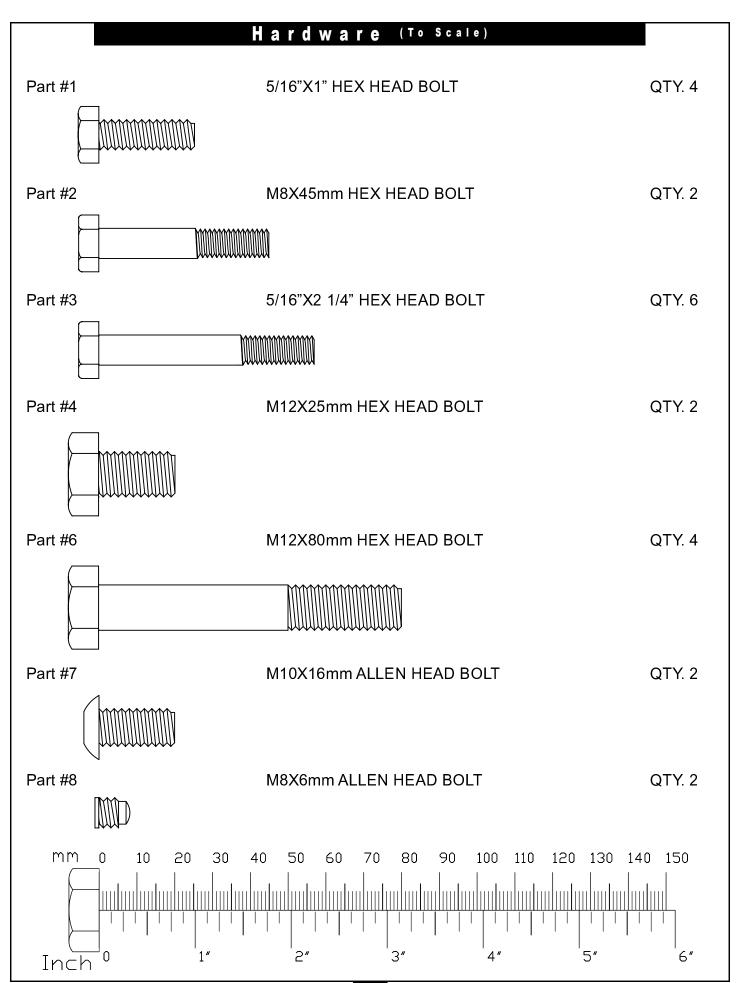

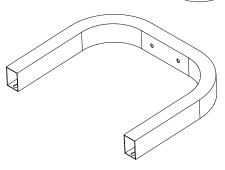
PART F -- MAIN CONNECTOR, 1 PCS

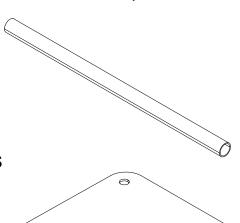
PART G -- SEAT ADJUSTER, 1PCS



PART H -- BASE FRAME, 1 PCS

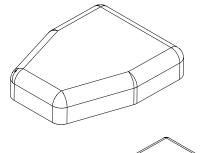


PART I -- ROLLER ROD, 2 PCS

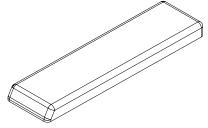


PART J -- PAD CONNECTOR, 1 PCS

1

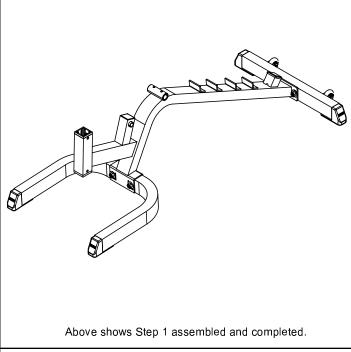
Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.

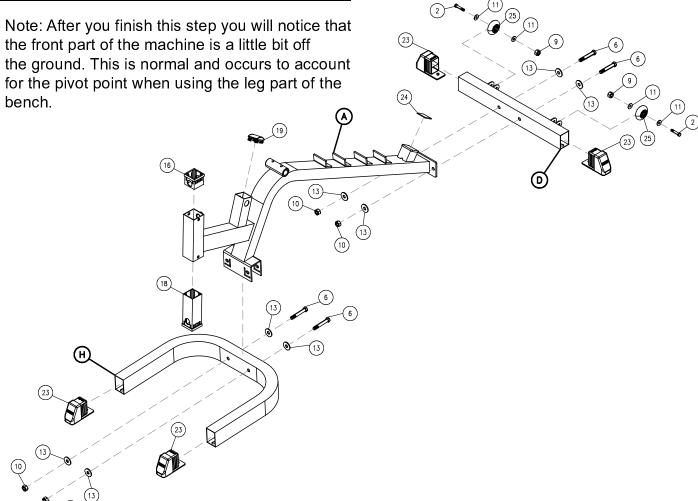
NOTE:

Finger tighten all hardware in this step. DO NOT wrench tighten until the last step. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

- 1A. Attach Base Frame (**H**) to Mainframe (**A**) using:
 - 2 (#6) M12X80mm Hex Head Bolt
 - 4 (#13) 12mmX37mm Flat Washer
 - 2 (#10) M12 Nylon Lock Nut
- 1B. Attach Rear Frame (**D**) to Mainframe (**A**) using:
 - 2 (#6) M12X80mm Hex Head Bolt
 - 4 (#13) 12mmX37mm Flat Washer
 - 2 (#10) M12 Nylon Lock Nut
- 1C. Attach Rubber Wheels to Rear Frame (**D**) using:
 - 2 (#25) Ø64mm Rubber Wheel
 - 2 (#2) M8X45mm Hex Head Bolt
 - 4 (#11) 8mmX24mm Flat Washer
 - 2 (#9) M8 Nylon Lock Nut
- 1D. Insert Foot Caps onto ends of Rear Frame (**D**) and Base Frame (**H**) using:
 - 4 (#23) 50X75mm Foot Cap
- 1E. Insert Nylon Bushings into front end openings of Mainframe (A), smaller one goes in on top, larger in on bottom, using:
 - 1 (#16) 60X45X40mm Nylon Bushing
 - 1 (#18) 60X45X130mm Nylon Bushing
- 1F. Insert End Cap into middle opening of Mainframe (A) using:
 - 1 (#19) 50X50mm Convex End Cap
- 1G. Insert Rubber Catch onto end post of Mainframe (A) using:
 - 1 (#24) 38X38mm Rubber Catch







STEP 2

Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.

NOTE:

Finger tighten all hardware in this step. DO NOT wrench tighten until the last step. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

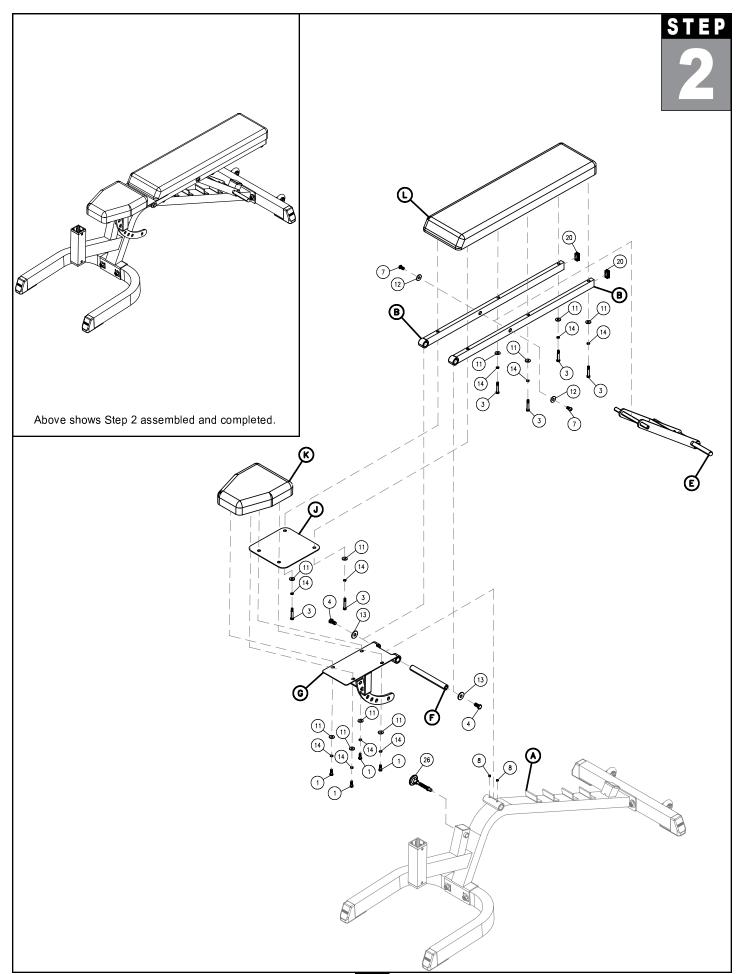
2A. This Step involves connecting all parts except part (**E**, **J**, **K**, **and L**) to Mainframe (**A**).

Insert Main Connector (**F**) thru slot of one Support Frame (**B**), followed by right slot of Seat Adjuster (**G**), followed by slot on top of Mainframe (**A**), followed by left slot of Seat Adjuster (**G**), finishing with slot of the other Support Frame (**B**). Secure all parts using:

- 2 (#4) M12X25mm Hex Head Bolt
- 2 (#13) 12mmX37mm Flat Washer
- 2B. Secure Main Connector (**F**) to Mainframe (**A**) using:
 - 2 (#8) M8X6mm Allen Head Bolt
- 2C. Screw in Mushroom Pin (#26) into Mainframe (A) to secure and adjust height of Seat Adjuster (G).
- 2D. Attach Pad Connector (**J**) followed by Seat Pad (**K**) to Seat Adjuster (**G**) using:
 - 4 (#1) 5/16"X1" Hex Head Bolt
 - 4 (#14) 8mm Spring Washer
 - 4 (#11) 8mmX24mm Flat Washer

Note: When attaching the pad connector you must attach the closer holes of the pad connector to the rear set of holes on the seat adjuster.

- 2E. Attach Bench Adjuster (**E**) to both Support Frames (**B**) using:
 - 2 (#7) M10X16mm Allen Head Bolt
 - 2 (#12) 10mmX30mm Flat Washer
- 2F. Attach Bench Pad (**L**) to Support Frames (**B**) and Pad Connector (**J**) using:
 - 6 (#3) 5/16"X2 1/4" Hex Head Bolt
 - 6 (#14) 8mm Spring Washer
 - 6 (#11) 8mmX24mm Flat Washer
- 2G. Insert End Caps into ends of Support Frames (B) using:
 - 2 (#20) 20X40mm End Cap



STEP 3

Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.

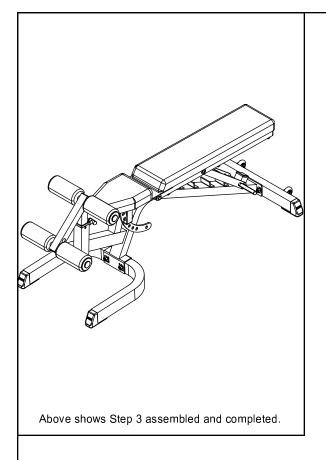

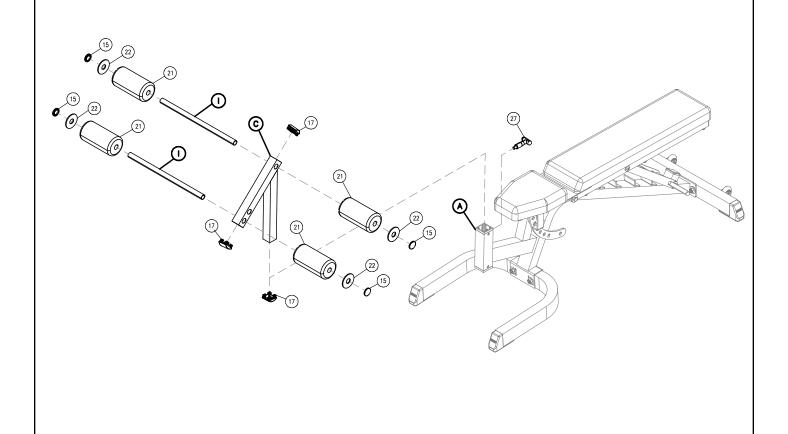
Finger tighten all hardware in this step. DO NOT wrench tighten until the last step. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

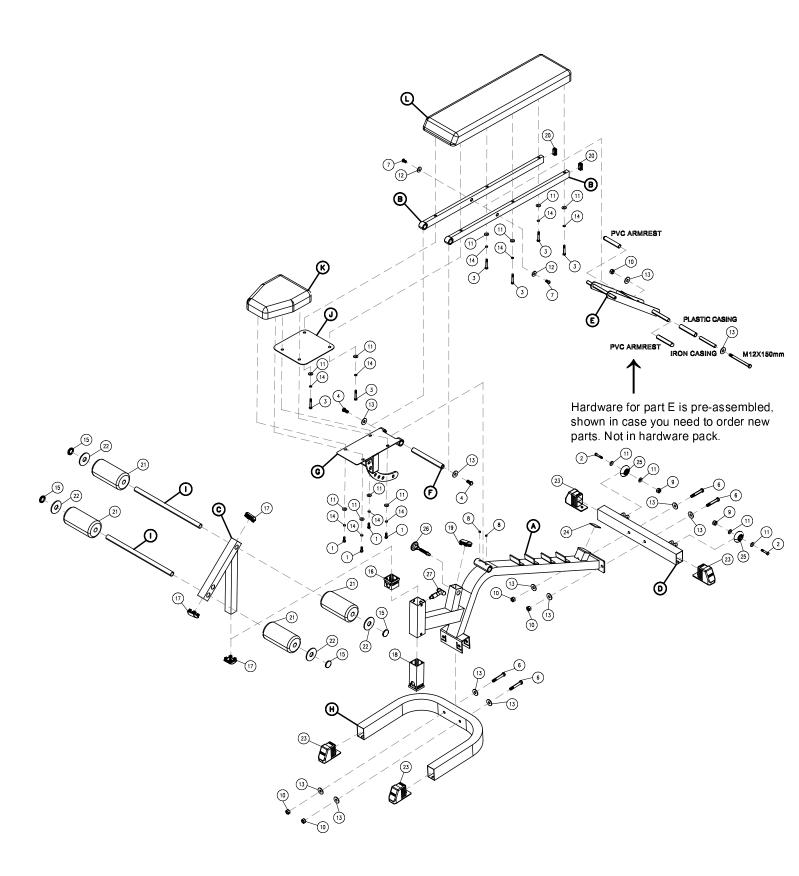
- 3A. Screw T-Handle Pin (#27) into leg adjuster portion of Mainframe (A).
- 3B. Insert Leg Adjuster (**C**) into front opening of Mainframe (**A**) and secure and adjust using T-Handle Pin.
- 3C. Insert one Roller Rod (I) halfway into top opening of Leg Adjuster (C) and another Roller Rod (I) halfway into one of the bottom openings of Leg Adjuster (C).

Note: Bottom opening selection is based on your height and what feels more comfortable to you.

- 3D. Insert Foam Roller, followed by Nylon Washer, finishing with Round End Cap onto each end of Roller Rods (I) using:
 - 4 (#21) Foam Roller
 - 4 (#22) Ø75mm Nylon Washer
 - 4 (#15) Ø25mm Round End Cap
- 3E. Insert End Caps into all three openings of Leg Adjuster (**C**):
 - 3 (#17) 45X45mm Convex End Cap
