

PFI 150 SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

WHEN USING EXERCISE EQUIPMENT, YOU SHOULD ALWAYS TAKE BASIC PRECAUTIONS INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING:

- Read all instructions before using the PFI150. These instructions are written to ensure your safety and to protect the unit.
- Do not remove any safety labels from the machine.
- Do not allow children on or near the equipment.
- Use the equipment only for its intended purpose as described in this guide. Do not use accessory attachments that are not recommended by the manufacturer. Such attachments might cause serious injuries.
- Wear proper excercise clothing and shoes for your workout, no loose clothing.
- Keep hands, limbs, loose clothing, and long hair well out of the way of all moving parts
- Use care when getting on or off the unit.
- Do no overexert yourself or work to exhaustion.
- If you feel any pain or abnormal symptoms, stop your workout immediately and consult your physician.
- Never operate unit when it has been dropped or damaged. Return the equipment to a service center for examination and repair.
- Never drop or insert objects into any opening in the

- Do not use the equipment outdoors or near water.

- Assemble and operate the PFI150 on a solid, level surface. Locate the unit a few feet from the walls or furniture to provide easy access.

The PFI150 is designed for your enjoyment. By following these precautions and using common sense, you will have many safe and pleasurable hours of healthful exercise with your Powerline Flat Incline Bench.

After assembly, you should check all functions to ensure correct operation. If you experience problems, first recheck the assembly instructions to locate any possible errors made during assembly. PREPARATION

REQUIRED TOOLS

The basic tools that you must obtain before assembling the PFI150 include but are not limit to:

- · Standard Wrench Set
- Metric Wrench Set
- Adjustable Wrench
- Standard / Metric Allen Key Set

INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS

Follow these installation requirements when assembling the PFI150:

Set up the PFI150 on a solid, flat surface. A smooth, flat surface under the machine helps keep it level.

Provide ample space around the machine. Open space around the machine allows for easier access.

For aesthetic purposes, insert all bolts in the same direction unless specified (in text or illustrations) to do otherwise.

Leave room for adjustments. Tighten fasteners such as bolts, nuts, and screws so the unit is stable, but leave room for adjustments. Do not fully tighten fasteners until instructed in the assembly steps to do so.

Fill out and mail the warranty card.

If you need to order replacement parts please be prepared to provide the following information when contacting us so that we can assist you better.

- 1. Model Number
- 2. Place of Purchase
- 3. Serial Number (S/N)
- 4. Part # and Description

Read all "Notes" on each page before beginning each step.


While you may be able to assemble the PFI150 using the illustrations only, important safety notes and other tips may be included in the text.

Some pieces may have extra holes that you will not use. Use only those holes indicated in the instructions and illustrations.

NOTE: With so many assembled parts, proper alignment and adjustment is critical. While tightening the nuts and bolts, be sure to leave room for adjustments.

NOTE: The bottles that are marked "Poison" is your touch up paint. Keep away from children.



 - 2 (#6) M8x45MM HEX HEAD BOLT
 - 4 (#11) M8 WASHER
 - 2 (#15) M8 NYLON LOCK NUT





 - 1 (#2) M12X120MM HEX HEAD BOLT
 - 2 (#8) M12 WASHER
 - 1 (#13) M12 NYLON LOCK NUT






