

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# Important Safety Instructions

## **When using exercise equipment, you should always take basic precautions, including the following:**

- Read all instructions before using the **SFI20**. These instructions are written to ensure your safety and to protect the unit.
- **Do not remove any safety labels from the machine.**
- Do not allow children on or near the equipment.
- Use the equipment only for its intended purpose as described in this guide. Do not use accessory attachments that are not recommended by the manufacturer. Such attachments might cause injuries.
- Wear proper exercise clothing and shoes for your workout, no loose clothing.
- Keep hands, limbs, loose clothing, and long hair well out of the way of all moving parts.
- Use care when getting on or off the unit.
- Do not overexert yourself or work to exhaustion.
- If you feel any pain or abnormal symptoms, stop your workout immediately and consult your physician.
- Never operate unit when it has been dropped or damaged. Return the equipment to a service center for examination and repair.
- Never drop or insert objects into any opening in the equipment.
- Always check the unit and its cables before each use. Make sure that all fasteners and cables are secure and in good working condition.

- Assemble and operate the **SFI20** on a solid, level surface. Locate the unit a few feet from the walls or furniture to provide easy access.

After assembly, you should check all functions to ensure correct operation. If you experience problems, first recheck the assembly instructions to locate any possible errors made during assembly. # Preparation

Thank you for purchasing the **SFI20**. This bench is part of the Body-Solid line of quality strength training machines, which lets you target specific muscle groups to achieve better muscle tone and overall body conditioning. To maximize your use of the equipment please study this Owner's Manual thoroughly.

## Required Tools

The basic tools that you must obtain before assembling the **SFI20** include but are not limited to:

- Metric Allen Key Set
- Standard Allen Key Set
- Standard Wrench Set
- Metric Wrench Set
- Adjustable Wrench
- Screwdriver (standard and/or phillips)

## Installation Requirements

Follow these installation requirements when assembling the **SFI20**:

Set up the **SFI20** on a solid, flat surface. A smooth, flat surface under the machine helps keep it level. A level machine has fewer malfunctions.

Provide ample space around the machine. Open space around the machine allows for easier access.

Insert all bolts in the same direction. For aesthetic purposes, insert all bolts in the same direction unless specified (in text or illustrations) to do otherwise.

Leave room for adjustments. Tighten fasteners such as bolts, nuts, and screws so the unit is stable, but leave room for adjustments. Do not fully tighten fasteners until instructed in the assembly steps to do so.

**Fill out and mail the warranty card.**

## Assembly Tips

Read all "Notes" on each page before beginning each step.


While you may be able to assemble the **SFI20** using the illustrations only, important safety notes and other tips are included in the text.

Some pieces may have extra holes that you will not use. Use only those holes indicated in the instructions and illustrations.

**NOTE:** With so many assembled parts, proper alignment and adjustment is critical. While tightening the nuts and bolts, be sure to leave room for adjustments.

**NOTE:** The bottles that are marked "Poison" is your touch up paint. Keep away from children.

**CAUTION:** Obtain assistance! If you feel like you can't assemble the **SFI20** by yourself then do not attempt to do so as this could result in injury. Review the installation requirements before proceeding with the following steps.

**Finger tighten all hardware first in this step. Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of and after STEP 1D. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.**

- 1A.** Attach Front Leg (B) to Front Stabilizer (A) using:  
(#2) M12x100mm Hex Head Bolt, QTY 2  
(#10) M12 Flat Washer, QTY 4  
(#13) M12 Nylon Lock Nut, QTY 2
  
- 1B.** Attach Rear Leg (D) to Rear Stabilizer (C) using:  
(#2) M12x100mm Hex Head Bolt, QTY 2  
(#10) M12 Flat Washer, QTY 4  
(#13) M12 Nylon Lock Nut, QTY 2
  
- 1C.** Attach Front Leg (B) to Main Frame (F) using:  
(#3) M12x25mm Hex Head Bolt, QTY 2  
(#10) M12 Flat Washer, QTY 2
  
- 1D.** Attach Rear Leg (D) to Main Frame (F) using:  
(#3) M12x25mm Hex Head Bolt, QTY 2  
(#10) M12 Flat Washer, QTY 2




**NOTE:**

**Finger tighten all hardware first in this step. Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of and after STEP 2C. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.**

- 2A.** Attach Back Adjustment Bracket (**J**) to Back Frame (**K**) using:  
(#5) M10x16mm Hex Head Bolt, QTY 4  
(#11) M10 Flat Washer, QTY 4
  
- 2B.** Rotate Back Frame (**K**) to insert Back Adjustment Bracket (**J**) into the Main Frame (**F**).
  
- 2C.** Attach Plastic Sleeve (**#19**) to Back Adjustment Bracket (**J**) using:  
(#9) M8x20mm Socket Head Cap Screw, QTY 1  
(#12) M8 Flat Washer, QTY 1  
(#14) M8 Nylon Lock Nut, QTY 1


**STEP****3**

**Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.**


**NOTE:**

**Finger tighten all hardware first in this step. Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of and after STEP 3C. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.**

- 3A.** Attach Seat Adjustment Bracket (**G**) to Seat Frame (**H**) using:  
(#5) M10x16mm Hex Head Bolt, QTY 2  
(#11) M10 Flat Washer, QTY 2
  
- 3B.** Rotate Seat Frame (**H**) to Insert Seat Adjustment Bracket (**G**) into the Main Frame (**F**).
  
- 3C.** Attach Plastic Sleeve (**#19**) to Seat Adjustment Bracket (**G**) using:  
(#9) M8x20mm Socket Head Cap Screw, QTY 1  
(#12) M8 Flat Washer, QTY 1  
(#14) M8 Nylon Lock Nut, QTY 1






- 4A.** Attach Seat Pad (#20) to Seat Frame (H) using:  
(#8) M8x25mm Hex Head Bolt, QTY 2  
(#12) M8 Flat Washer, QTY 2
  
- 4B.** Attach Back Pad (#21) to Back Frame (K) using:  
(#8) M8x25mm Hex Head Bolt, QTY 3  
(#12) M8 Flat Washer, QTY 3
